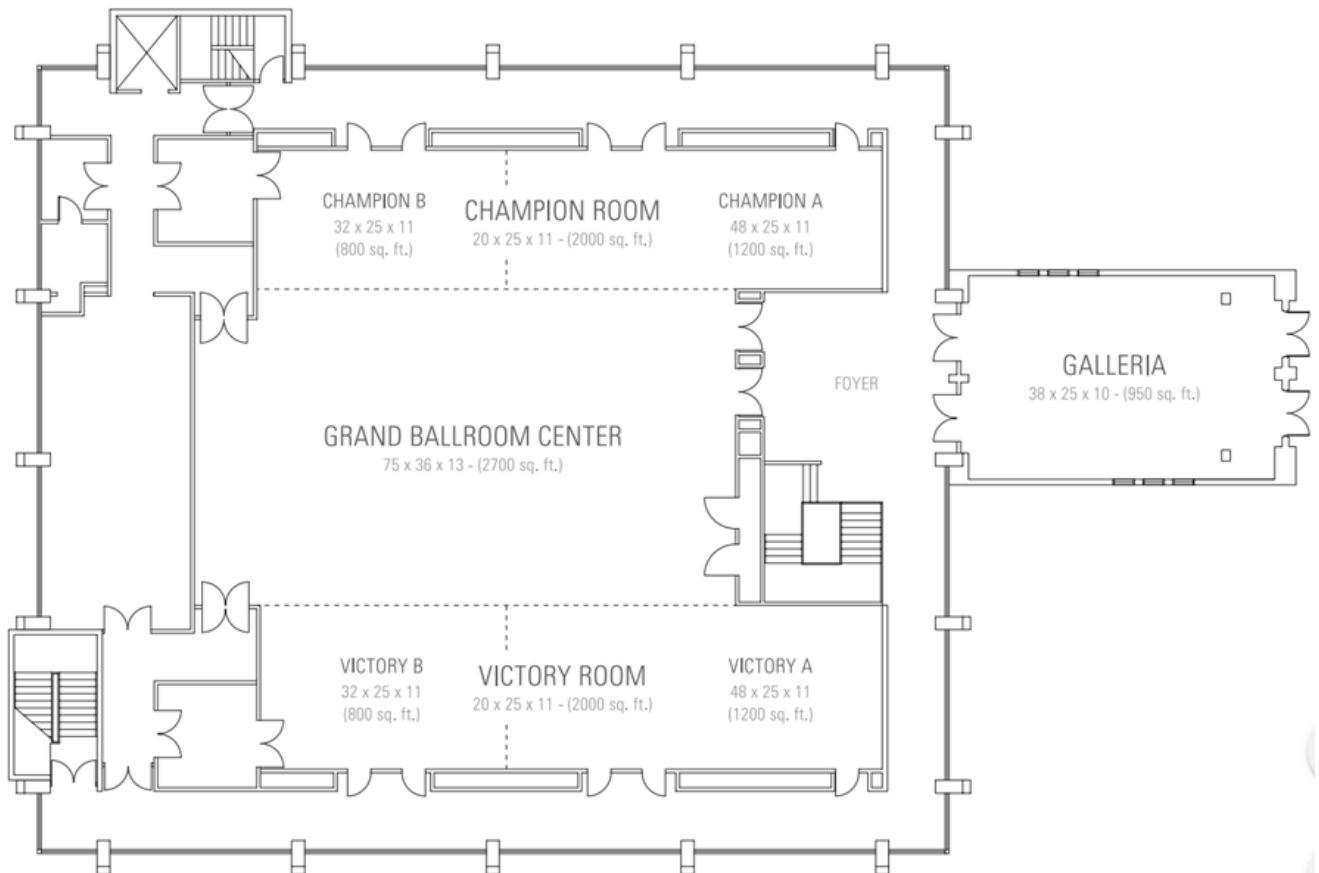

Formal Meeting Rules

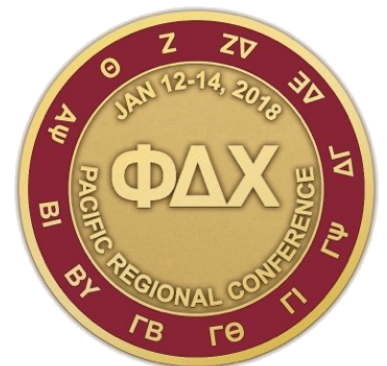
- For delegates to speak on an issue
 - Rise and address the Presiding Officer using the official symbol of recognition of Phi Delta Chi
 - Give your Name and Chapter
 - Obtain recognition from the Presiding Officer
- A Brother may not speak a second time on the same issue if another Brother who has not yet spoken asks for the floor. No Brother may speak more than twice on the same issue, except by unanimous consent of the Regional Conference Delegation.
- No resolutions introduced by the reference committees shall be voted upon until the Formal Meeting.
- Discussions on questions (motions and resolutions) shall be limited to not more than five minutes for each speaker. Discussion on any one question shall be limited to not more than 30 minutes. Both time limits may be changed by appealing to the Presiding Office or by two-thirds vote of the Regional Conference Delegation present.
- Discussion on issues may be tabled only upon a two-thirds vote of the Pacific Regional Conference Delegation present.

Recommended Attire

- Friday night social activities: casual attire, Phi Delta Chi shirts
- Saturday night social activities: club attire (there may be strict dress codes in downtown)
- Business Meetings & Workshops: business casual
- Banquet: cocktail/semi-formal/formal attire
- Formal Meeting: business attire

Policy on Name Badges

- Name badges must be worn visibly in all Regional Conference sessions, including receptions and banquet. Badges are required for admission into all Regional Conference functions, except Friday & Saturday night social activities.



Conference Etiquette

Dr. Anderson is currently completing the second year of a PGY1/PGY2 Health-System Pharmacy Administration Residency at UW Medicine in Seattle, Washington. He is concurrently earning an Executive Masters of Health Administration from the University of Washington School of Public Health. He graduated with honors from Wingate University School of Pharmacy in 2016 upon completing a PharmD/MBA dual degree program.

Dr. Anderson has previously served on the ASHP Pharmacy Student Forum Executive Committee and the ASHP Council on Education and Workforce Development. He is actively involved with Phi Delta Chi as Chair of the Grand Council Review Committee, Washington State Pharmacists Association (WSPA) as the Resident member of the Health Systems Academy Leadership team, and the ASHP Membership and Outreach Advisory Group.

Dr. Evans is the senior vice president and CEO for Sharp Grossmont Hospital and also oversees Sharp's pharmacy services across the system. Dr. Evans joined Sharp HealthCare in 2015. Prior to joining Sharp, he served as the chief executive officer of Keck Hospital of USC and USC Norris Cancer Hospital. Prior to that appointment, he was chief operating officer for the two university-owned hospitals, a position he held since 2007. He also holds an appointment as associate dean for academic medical center programs in the USC School of Pharmacy.

Dr. Evans began his career in health care in 1989 as a pharmacy technician. After becoming a pharmacist, and subsequently a director of pharmacy, Dr. Evans accepted a position in hospital administration in Los Angeles overseeing pharmacy, laboratory services, radiology, quality, infection prevention and risk management before becoming COO.

Dr. Evans obtained his doctor of pharmacy degree at the USC School of Pharmacy with postgraduate residency training at the Department of Veterans Affairs and the USC School of Pharmacy. He also holds a master of health administration from the USC Sol Price School of Public Policy, and he is currently pursuing a doctorate in education with an emphasis in organizational leadership from Pepperdine University. Dr. Evans's area of interest for his dissertation research is organizational culture and its impact on health-related outcomes.

Jeffrey A. Goad, PharmD, MPH, FAPhA, FCPHA, FCSHP (Omicron)

Professor & Chair, Department of Pharmacy Practice, Chapman University School of Pharmacy



Dr. Goad is the Professor and Chair of the Department of Pharmacy Practice at Chapman University School of Pharmacy. He received his Doctor of Pharmacy degree from the University of Southern California School of Pharmacy in 1994 and Masters of Public Health from the USC Keck School of Medicine in 2003. He completed a residency in pediatric pharmacy practice at Children's Hospital Los Angeles and holds the Certificate of Knowledge in Travel Health from the International Society of Travel Medicine. Dr. Goad is the immediate Past-President of the California Immunization Coalition, the first pharmacist to lead the group. He is also the immediate Past-Chair and founding member of the Pharmacists Professional Group Section of the International Society of Travel Medicine. Previously, Dr. Goad served as the President of the California Pharmacists Association.

In 2000, Dr. Goad established and ran the Student Health Travel Medicine Clinic until 2014. He teaches and coordinates courses in public health and travel medicine as well as teaching immunizations, epidemiology, and parasitology. He is currently a national faculty trainer for the American Pharmacists Association Pharmacy Based Immunization Training Program and the APhA Pharmacy-Based Travel Health Services Advanced Certificate Training.

Dr. Goad established and directed of the USC Community Pharmacy Practice Residency program for the last 15 years and has implemented numerous community based patient care programs including a travel health clinic, tuberculosis compliance clinic, emergency contraceptive service, immunization program, and multiphasic disease state screenings. In addition, Dr. Goad was the Director of the Office of Student Outreach for Community Health.

Dr. Goad has presented papers at numerous pharmacy and medical conferences around the world. He lectures and writes extensively on the topic of travel health, community acquired infectious diseases, immunization practices, and community pharmacy programs. He is also a reviewer for several journals on the topic of community pharmacy practice.
